TODAY'S GOSPEL - Jesus was in good company when he fed the five thousand. The Old Testament tells us that the prophet Elisha fed one hundred men with twenty loaves. As the account in 2 Kings 4:42-44 makes clear, this provision was truly miraculous. However, it almost pales into insignificance when compared to Jesus' miracle of feeding over five thousand people with only five loaves and two fish! What then is the deeper meaning of this miracle, for Jesus' miracles always have deeper meanings, secrets to give up, revelation to unveil and share? Tradition has always understood the feeding miracles as in some way pointing to the nourishment we receive from the bread of the Eucharist. The miracle before us today in a very real sense points to the forthcoming Last Supper where Jesus will break bread and institute the sacrament of the Eucharist.
