SPUC PETITION to revoke Marie Stopes licence. The Care Quality Commission investigation uncovered 2,600 incidents relating to safety in 2015/16 e.g. receptionists/health care workers completing consent forms instead of doctors, risk assessments not being carried out, doctors leaving premises while women were still under sedation, foetuses being put in dustbins to avoid clinical waste costs.
