THOUGHTS FOR TODAY - Life as a Christian demands a lot of the believer. Today Jesus talks about who will and who won't be allowed into the Kingdom of God. He warns his listeners then and now to do more than just listen to his teaching. For some people listening to Jesus' teaching became an intellectual excerise. They treated Jesus as just another Rabbi, asking theoretical questions like the one in verse 23 and taking for granted that they would be saved. Jesus compared the Kingdom of God to a house with a very small entrance. People are struggling to get in but the owner has closed the door and is only allowing certain people to enter. Jesus is making his meaning very clear. There has to be a personal entering into faith in God by believing in Jesus and then a practical application of faith to every part of our lives.
